WSU Tri-Cities Campus Goals 2016-2017 Academic Year

Domain: Dynamic Student Engagement

- 1. To increase student enrollment from 1593 headcount to 1700 by the end of the 2016-2017academic year
- 2. To stabilize overall student retention from year to year by the end of the 2016-2017 academic year.

Dynamic Research Engagement

- 1. To increase total research dollars by 5% by the end of the 2016-2017 Academic Year.
- 2. Increase collaborations with external governmental agencies and companies and quantify a baseline for campus collaborations in research.
- 3. Develop a plan to implement the Wine Science Center to foster world class research and education.
- 4. Develop new and existing faculty research laboratories in education and liberal arts.

Domain: Dynamic Community Engagement

- 1. To increase number of students participating in community service from 200 to 250 students by the end of the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 2. To stabilize campus annual fundraising back to \$2.5 million from \$900K in 2016-17.
- 3. Stabilize and increase the partnerships for student employment six month after graduation and compare our rate to the national average. (i.e., 92% in 2015-16)

Domain: Institutional Effectiveness

- 1. To implement a campus continuous improvement process of project management (spreadsheets) by the end of the 2016-2017 academic year.
- 2. Work to reduce the campus expenditures and increase overall PBL funding.
- 3. Work to complete the student union project on campus by June 2016.
- 4. Work with developers to open new student housing by August 2017.
- 5. Hire a new Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs in 2016-17, and build a highly functioning executive team on campus.
- 6. Communicate with the campus RFO and general faculty to build accountability, organizational trust and buy in to the campus priorities and objectives.
- 7. Work with the Chancellor's Executive Council to build a culture of inclusion on campus through various workshops and campus town halls.
- 8. Build a more collaborative and collegial environment for WSU-TC within the WSU family of campuses.
