4. Action Items

- Student Feedback on S&A Fee
 - o Open Floor for feedback and perspective from any students at the meeting
 - o Gianna DiMeo (Student at large):
 - Shared that students don't understand why they have to pay fees while virtual this semester
 - There is a need to share more information about what the fees are being used for
 - If there is the possibility to reduce the fee, students who be greatly appreciated
 - o Robin:
 - Students can see that the services and activities that are usually offered with this money so a refund is being "requested"
 - o Nan:
 - Students aren't sure why they are paying the full amount and why hasn't there been any information
 - More communication about the fees is needed
 - o Gianna:
 - If not reduced consider how to reallocated to better engage students while virtual and at a distance
 - o Robin:
 - Make sure that these areas are able to provide opportunities to students whenever we do get back to in-person activities
- Fee Recommendation for Fall 2020
 - o The committee reviewed the documents filed by each funded area and what their "natural" cuts would include and how the collective cuts would impact the bottom line of the budget
 - o Discussion about what the impact on Spring might be for those

departments who receive funds

- There was a discussion about if the reduction should be partially taken from the Reserves
- The group saw that the dollar amount related of the natural cut was close to the 25% cut dollar amount
- A question was raised about why ASWSUTC and SEB wasn't reducing their budgets as much as other areas
 - They are less active but they are still reaching out to students and engaging a fair number of students
- Clubs are having a hard time to engage students as well but they also want to be able to be active
- **Nick moved to recommend a refund to the Fall S&A Fee of 25%, Jenni seconded, passed unanimously.**
