



WSU Tri-Cities Undergraduate Student Retention Rates-1st Year





WSU Tri-Cities Graduation rate 4th year





Research Grants Received





Goal: WSU Tri-Cities set a goal to be awarded 5 outreach grants for FY21 and exceeded that goal.



Percentage of Students of Color Full-Time Students











Percentage of Students Receiving Washington College Grant





Percentage of Students Completed FAFSA







Goal: WSU Tri-Cities set a goal for students to complete their degree with less than \$20,000 in debt following graduation.




