



Academic Advising

All TRIO students have an assigned TRIO specialist that will help them review schedules, course selection and assist with meeting program graduation requirements. Additionally, students receive coaching where they are challenged to relate their personal and/or professional goals to their academic goals.

Supplemental Instruction

Supplemental instructors are current graduate students or have graduate and doctoral degrees. Supplemental instructors partner with faculty to offer more intensive academic assistance which is a combination of teaching core content and useful study strategies used in small group or one-one study sessions.





Cultural Enrichment

TRIO provides participants opportunities to attend a variety of events to help them expand their knowledge and appreciation for arts and other cultures. Last semester TRIO hosted a virtual event and a drive-up Goodie bag pick-up, to celebrate National First-Generation Day and the acedemic achievements they have accomplished.

Career Leadership & Development

TRIO specialists help students create resumes and cover letters that contain multiple aspects and steps for career and leadership development. Together they create strength assessment tools and a plan to develop the necessary skills for the advancing work force of today.

TRIO Received a new STEM and Health Sciences grant through the Department of Education to serve an additional 120 students for 5 years at WSU Tri-Cities

WSU Tri-Cities received \$2.6 million in TRIO Student Success Programs grant funding, through the Department of Education, to serve 260 students across campus for the 2020-2025 academic years. This includes a new STEM grant, which assists students who are pursuing STEM and Health Sciences majors.




