TRIO SERVICES

TRIO Advising

All TRIO students have an assigned TRIO Advisor that will help them review schedules and course selection, while assisting with meeting program graduation requirements. Students receive coaching through a tiered process, where they are challenged to relate their personal and/or professional goals to their academic goals.

Academic Specialists

Academic Specialists are current graduate students pursuing Masters or Doctoral degrees, or have a graduate background. Specialists provide holistic support from tutoring and mentoring to useful study and organizational strategies. Sessions are in the Learning Commons and are small group or one-one.

STEM Support/ Research

TRIO focuses on supporting students pursuing STEM and Health Science Degrees. TRIO provides opportunities to attend Research Symposiums and STEM based workshops. Through the UNIV 199 course, students learn about how to get involved with research and connect with faculty to work on projects. The goal is to have students apply their STEM skills and gain hands on experience before graduating.


SUCCESS STORY
