Leadership for the 21st Century

Length: Four-Day
Cost: \$1,995

This workshop is intended for leaders at all levels. It is the foundation to developing an individual's natural style of leadership by focusing on one's Personal and Professional Intelligence. This fast-paced four-day workshop dives deep into the core concepts of effective leadership.

Authentic Leadership

Length: Three-Day
Cost: \$1,395

An authentic leader serves as a role model for moral and fair behavior. This leader is transparent, emotionally intelligent, and commands esteem and confidence from employees. This workshop includes a comprehensive emotional intelligence assessment to identify the participant's natural style of leadership.
